Curriculum



We will use the Spark! Lectionary curriculum. It is creative, full of life and energy and we are sure that your kids will enjoy learning more about Jesus! The lessons will usually match the Scripture from Worship. The Bibles we use coincide with this curriculum (all stories are found in the Spark Story Bible)

Learning Rotation

Students will begin in their assigned classroom. Then move to large group interaction and then back to classroom for focused Bible discussion. Usually there will also be a learning rotation of music, cooking, art, library, movie or science. At the end of the session students will return back to their classroom for pick up.



Bring Your Bible

Colorful Spark Story Bibles for 3year olds -2nd grade) are available for purchase for \$15 each. In the fall of each year, 3rd graders are presented with Bibles to use throughout their years. Please bring your Bible with you each week to Sunday School!
