Devotion

For you are a people holy to the Lord your God. (Deuteronomy 7:6)

God did not choose us so that we could be like everyone else. When we who place our faith in God are few in number compared to those of other beliefs and value systems, it can be difficult to maintain our identity. It can be challenging to remain distinct from those among whom we live, work, shop, and play. Those who are in the majority always seem to exert pressure upon others to conform to their beliefs and behavior.

So how do we maintain our idenity as God's children when we are in the minority? First, we can realize that it is God, and not us, who takes the initiative. "Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, the faithful God who maintains covenant loyalty" (v. 9). We have a responsibility to obey God's word (v. 11), but we do not do so alone. God is there to help us when we are not among fellow believers, and the Spirit is present in our midst to provide us aid and comfort. So, although we might be outnumbered in our community, God is stronger than any human adversary. The Lord will not allow us to be overcome or defeated.

Let us pray: Holy God, help us to remain true to you, through Christ. Amen.
