Friends in Christ,

This week, I'm confessing to being a Minnesota Twins fan. As you may know, the Twins have had four very bad seasons in a row and have begun this year on a trajectory to be even worse. Why would anyone be foolish enough to care about grown men playing a game for which they are paid millions by billionaires in stadiums paid for by taxpayers, many of whom have nothing? As is the case about many things, I don't have an answer.

Perhaps a good clergy person would get up on a soapbox and rant about the inherent evil of professional baseball, sports in general and any other non-utilitarian activities which draw interest and resources from concerns which really do matter. However, the church may have far too often taken an unrealistically snobby approach to such questions. Perhaps it time for us to accept our culture, context and neighbor for who they are and where they are. So what good are the Twins? Well, not very, at least not now!
