Pastoral Devotion

Friends in Christ,

Monday Diana and I joined the "Over 55" group from St. James Lutheran for a delicious, gourmet meal at Hennepin Technical School in Brooklyn Park. "Over 55" doesn't mean that this is a club for habitual speeders, but rather is a Christian fellowship group folks in our congregation who have surpassed the age of 55. The meal was great, and so was the fellowship. For desert, we had "Fallen Chocolate Dessert."
