Pastoral Devotion

In last Sunday's Adult Bible study at St. James, we engaged in a lively conversation which included personal experiences of the supernatural power and presence of God, confrontations with evil, and God's redeeming love. As I reflect on our conversation in this season of Advent, an axiom I've heard several times comes to mind, "The Gospel is not a fire insurance policy for the next world, but a life assurance policy for this world." We need not look far to see evil at work in this world. In fact, John the Baptizer encourages us to look closely, in our own hearts to find it. "John the baptizer appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins." Mark 1:4. Repentance is the spiritual practice of self-reflection on the ways in which we have turned from God, and then asking God to forgive us for our departures from God. In doing so, we prepare the way of the Lord in our hearts, relationships, and in our lives. May we live together in the Way of the Lord, the Way of love.
