### Weekly Devotion: 'Grief'

#### How long will you grieve? (1 Samuel 16:1)

Grief is a normal and natural response to loss. According to counselors, grieving allows us to free up energy bound to the person or object or experience we have lost. Until we go through the grieving process, we can't effectively move forward.

In today's text, God asks Samuel, "How long will you grieve over Saul?" (v.1). Samuel, it seems, is stuck in the past. He can't accept what has happened, that Saul's sin has caused God to reject him. God, on the other hand, is ready to move forward. "Fill your horn with oil and set out" (v.1), God commands. The welfare of the people of Israel is at stake. There is a new king to anoint.

How fortunate that God is willing to move on, that the welfare of God's children is foremost. Samuel is encouraged to trust God to take care of things. There is hope for the future. David is waiting in the wings. "rise and anoint him; for this is the one" (v. 12), says the Lord.

Healthy grieving is an active process. It involves acceptance, acknowledging our feelings, adjusting our lives to move forward, and saying good-bye. It also involves trusting God to handle things. We are not alone. We have a God who cares.

Loving God, thank you for your care, through Christ our Lord. Amen.
