### Pastoral Devotion

From over 100 applicants, 36 women were carefully selected to participate in a 3-day Charis spiritual retreat at the Minnesota State Correctional Facility for women in Shakopee. After a day of talks introducing them to God, the participants were invited to write the names of those who they needed to forgive on blank slips of white paper. Names of abusers, pushers, rapists, murderers, parents, friends, and for most, their own name. I was entrusted with the slips and charged with the task of burning them in my wood stove. When I arrived at home last Friday night, Diana had a nice fire burning, and I tossed the great flock of over fifty white slips of paper into the crackling flames. The slips flashed for an instant in the great power of the flames and were gone. Could the power of God's love and forgiveness be so strong that the uncounted years of heartache and sorrow and all of the enormous hurts and blinding, twisting guilt scrawled across those slips of paper be transformed in an instant of God's mercy and grace to light, heat, and a wisp of smoke rising to heaven?
