Pastoral Devotion

John 15.15: I do not call you servants any longer, because the servant does not know what the master is doing; but I have called you friends, because I have made known to you everything that I have heard from my Father.

"What a Friend We Have in Jesus" is a much beloved hymn in our Lutheran tradition (ELW 742). An elderly woman in her late 90s, who had lost her sight, much of her hearing, and was losing her memory, consistently asked that we sing this hymn when we shared in worship in her nursing home room. The hymn encourages us to come close to God through prayer, and experience friendship with God. My friend testified many times to strength and comfort she received through her prayer life and the meaning it gave her life. This week in worship, we will be celebrating Rally Sunday by welcoming new members and the friendships we share in Christ and with God.
