## Weekly Devotion: 'Maundy Thursday'

For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death. (1 Corinthians 11:26)

A person's obituary can be written in vivid detail or written rather sparsely, depending on the circumstances. Paul writes that as often as we eat the bread and drink the cup of the Lord's Supper, we proclaim Christ's death until he comes. But the kidn of proclamation Paul encourages is not the sort of death notice we'd find in a newspaper. Those who participate in the Lord's Supper walk away with more than the simple news that "Christ died." Rather, in this meal, we are reminded that Christ died to give his body and blood for the forgiveness of our sins.


It is no coincidence that in many celebrations of the Eucharist, worshipers respond: "Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again." This memorial acclamation reminds us that Christ's death is but one part of the larger story; the Father raised Jesus, and Christ himself has promised to return in glory. The One who poured out his flesh and blood for us gives us this promise to hold onto always– we have forgiveness of sins and eternal life in his name.

O Lord Jesus Christ, may the good news of your salvation always be upon my lips. Amen.
