Weekly Devotion: 'The Blessing

We bless you from the house of the Lord. (Psalm 118:26)

The word blessing comes from Latin and means "a good saying." When we bless, we pronounce a good word over someone. God's blessing plays an important role in our lives. We hear it in worship when the pastor speaks the blessing at the end of the service. We hear it in Baptism with these words: "I baptize you in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." In that moment, the pastor proclaims the blessing that the one baptized is a child of God forever.

We pronounce a blessing when we say "God bless you!" to someone. This is a way of living into the priesthood of all believers. In the book of James, we read about the power of the human tongue: "From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. My brothers and sisters, this ought not to be so" (James 3:10). Each day, we choose whether to bless or to criticize. We have the power to edify the body of Christ with good words or to diminish our witness with negative words.

"Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord" (v. 26). This verse is speaking about you and about me. Let's claim it and bless someone today!

Holy God, I bless you for making me your child in baptism, through Christ. Amen.
