## Devotion "The Truth-teller"

I am with you to save you and deliver you. (Jeremiah 15:20)

Jeremiah was a truth-teller. He made the people of Judah uncomfortable. He told them that their situation was worse than they imagined. He urged them not to count on God to deliver them from their foolishness. In return, the people cried: Don't be such a pessimist! Stop ruining our happiness. Life is good; enjoy it! History proved Jeremiah right, but that was small comfort for all the persecution he endured.

Or was it? When the prophet poured out his frustrations and pain to God, God told him his struggles would go on. At the same time, the Lord reassured him of God's presence. His enemies would not prevail. In a word, God gave Jeremiah the comfort of integrity. We are not always praised for being right. Still, it is better to be right than wrong, whether we get rewarded or not. Our satisfaction comes from within, not without. God's gift of integrity blesses us as well.

Lead me, dear Jesus, to count on your strength rather than relying on the praise of others. Amen.

### Worship Recommendation Decision

At our congregation's council meeting on August, 18, the worship committee's recommendation that our worship life continue into the fall with one worship service at 9:30 am was accepted and considered carefully. The council also considered the valuable feedback which it had received in the two listening sessions it sponsored on Wednesday night, August 13 at 7:00 p.m. and Sunday, August 17 following the 9:30 a.m. worship service. After thoughtful conversation in which many perspectives and preferences were shared, the council voted to adopt the worship committee's recommendation with the following changes and additions:

- 1. Beginning on Rally Sunday, September 7, 2014, the St. James worship schedule will be worship at 9:00 a.m.
- 2. A task force will begin immediately to gather the information and resources needed to create and implement a new worship service at St. James. This worship service will be held at a time and day to be finalized by the council upon receiving the recommendations of the New Worship Task Force.
