Devotion: Silence

A sound of sheer silence. (1 Kings 19:12)

The Lord speaks to Elijah, but not in wind or earthquake or fire, violent sounds of nature. Elijah experiences the voice of God in the "sound of sheer silence." God announces that the nation of Israel, in spite of being slaughtered by warring tribes, will survive as "seven thousand in Israel" (v. 18).

How hard it is to encounter silence in our lives! Even in worship, there is rarely a time when music or words do not fill the air. Sometimes, for a precious few moments, the soft footfalls of the faithful and the quietly spoken words, "The body of Christ broken for you; the blood of Christ shed for you" are the only sounds in the silence. "Be still, and know that I am God!" (Psalm 46:10). In the hush, we may listen for God's voice.

It is hard to find "sheer silence" in our world– however, the gentler sounds of nature– mountain breeze, rain on the prairie, waves on the beach, bubbling brooks– need not interfere with the hearing of God's voice. It is possible, indeed, to listen carefully for God speaking to us when we are accompanied by these sounds of creation, reminding us of our Creator.

Help me to be still, O God, and to hear your voice in the silent moments. In Jesus' name. Amen.
