Weekly Devotion: At Peace With God (Matthew 6:24-34)

Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life. (6:25)

Humans are prone to worry, especially about the future, because life takes many unexpected twists and turns. It's as if we believe that focusing on our worry will make us better prepared should the worst happen. Jesus cautions against allowing anxiety to overtake ou8r lives, because anxiety magnifies the smallest events into catastrophes. Not only does much of what we worry about never happen, worry uses energy that could be put to better use.

In place of worry, Jesus encourages us to trust. That doesn't mean we'll have everything we think we should or that life will be easy, but we will be more at peace. We'll have more clarity about when we need to act and when we need to hold still. We'll be given deeper understanding about which plans are part of God's leading and which stem from our anxiety.

To choose not to worry requires a tremendous amount of trust. Trust requires that we walk with God and learn something about God's faithfulness. Through the ups and downs of life, we learn God can be counted on to have our good at heart.

Your love, O God, gives me everything I need. Thank you, in Jesus' name. Amen.
