Beloved in Christ,

Last Sunday, Jesus invited us to imagine what the Kingdom of Heaven may be like, and to imagine that it is breaking open in our lives. This week, Jesus invites to consider the nature of power and how we can exercise our power in the world. Gerhard Frost offers one poetic perspective:
