Weekly Devotion: 'John the Baptist'

Who can endure the day of his coming? (Malachi 3:2)

OK, call me crazy, but I have been known to say that I look forward to God's judgment— and God's punishment. When I was on a bishop's staff, I slipped into a worship service unannounced and listed to a sermon that included an account of my yearning for God's judgment. I'm on record.

I think the worst punishment would be to have the Lord show me how I've sinned against God, my neighbor, and my-self in thought, word, and deed, by things done and things left undone. What is behind this craziness? I've figured it out. I want to know that God is truly aware of my "yucky-ness" and still loves me. I yearn for God to purify me even more completely than John the Baptist's water for repentance. I want to be rid of the unholy parts of my life's story.

Malachi's words are beautiful, especially when sung by the bass soloist in Handel's *Messiah*. Yet, I know that facing the Lord of hosts may be something I can't endure. Judgment could slam me to the ground just as Saul (later called Paul) was thrown into the dust on his way to Damascus.

May I rise up, O God, and become an offering that is pleasing to you. I seek you, Lord Jesus, and want to live in relationship with you. Amen.
