Weekly Devotion: 'After the Storm'

Then God said to Noah, "Go out of the ark." (Genesis 8:15-16)

Imagine what it must have been like for Noah and his family to leave the safety of the ark after the rains stopped. They set food on dry land, in a place that looked very different from their familiar homeland. What a challenge for them to begin all over again!

When the members of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Brant Beach, New Jersey, returned to their church building after Superstorm Sandy moved on, they found damage from wind, water, and sand. The electrical system was destroyed. The organ and piano were badly damaged. Carpets and pews were water-soaked. The church vegetable garden was washed away. But the stained glass windows—in vibrant blue hues, all depicting biblical scenes on or near the water—were secure.

As church leaders began to assess the damage, offers of assistance poured in. Lutheran Disaster Response, individual congregations, neighbors, members of Holy Trinity– all expressed a desire to help. The response was overwhelming and gratefully received.

Thank you, God, for your presence among us when we live through times of recovery. Help us to always trust in your goodness. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
